In the "Gewerbe- Adressbuch der österreichischen Monarchie" of 1856, in addition to the Michaelerhaus on Vienna's Kohlmarkt, a "shop for fashionable accessories and costume jewellery" is also mentioned "in Karlsbad on the meadow in the Haus zum Meerfräulein during the summer".

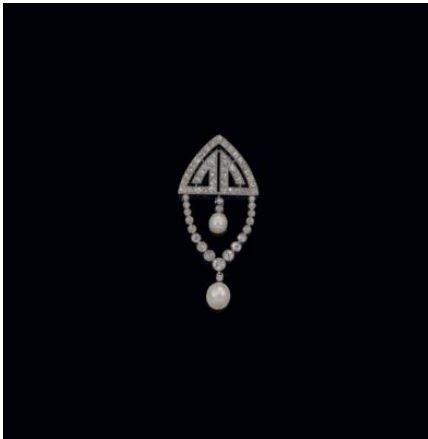

One of the offspring of this marriage was the daughter Archduchess Elisabeth Franziska, born on 27 January 1892, who received the brooch on the occasion of her engagement to Count Georg von Waldburg zu Zeil und Hohenems on 7 April 1912.

The island of Capri in the Gulf of Naples has fascinated travellers, artists and creatives for centuries with its pleasant climate, picturesque landscapes and blue sea.

It is said that St. Michel, with the gentle sound of a little bell, brought back a poor shepherd's only lamb, which had been deemed lost. As a result, the bell became a symbol of good fortune and a talisman of Capri.

The ambience of the island and the legend of the bell inspired Pietro Capuano - nicknamed Chantecler - heir to a family of Neapolitan jewelers, to create a bell as a pendant and offer it to an international audience in his boutique since 1950.

Other individual haute joaillerie creations by Chantecler are also clearly influenced by the magic of the 'Isola Azzurra'. Capri's unique colours are reflected in the untreated Pailin sapphires, which are reminiscent of the hues of the island's blue grotto, the 'Grotta azzurra'.

The shade of Pailin sapphires, which are rare today, varies from light to deep blue, with such a pronounced purity and intensity of colour that it is sometimes difficult to distinguish them from Kashmir sapphires. For this reason, these rare and exquisite blue sapphires from the Cambodian border with Thailand are often valued almost as highly as sapphires from the Kashmir Mountains.

The Italian goldsmith dynasty Castellani played a pivotal role in the revival of antique goldsmithing in 19th-century Rome. Inspired by the spectacular discovery of the Etruscan tomb in the Campana Collection, the Castellani workshop developed innovative goldsmithing techniques in an archaeological style.

Fortunato Pio Castellani laid the foundations of the company in 1814 and opened the first store on Via del Corso in Rome. His sons, Alessandro and Augusto, perpetuated the legacy of the company founder, facilitating the company's further expansion and enhanced reputation.

In 1860, Alessandro Castellani relocated to Paris, where he was able to expand his clientele to include influential aristocratic and industrial families. This helped the Castellani name to gain a great reputation. He later settled in Naples.

The present diadem embodies Castellani's antique style. The delicate leaves form a subtle head jewel in the shape of a gold laurel wreath. Archaeological finds of similar jewellery from the Campana collection can be found in the Hermitage Museum in St. Petersburg.¹ A similarly executed diadem is preserved in the Museo Nazionale Etrusco di Villa Giulia in Rome.² On the reverse is the signet CC for Castellani.

A laurel diadem appears in the inventory list of the store in Rome on 1 July 1862 in combination with the name Alessandro.³ A preparatory sketch can be found in the Museo d'Arte Industriale di Roma.⁴

The later box labelled 'Perez Naples' suggests that it was purchased in the Naples area.

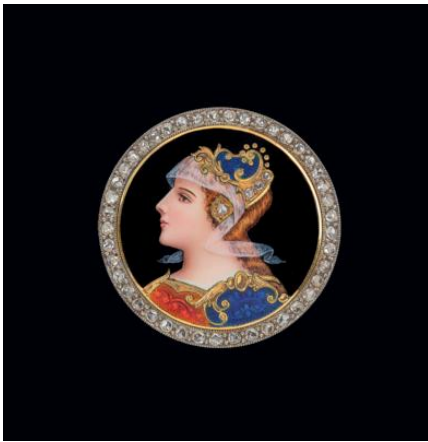

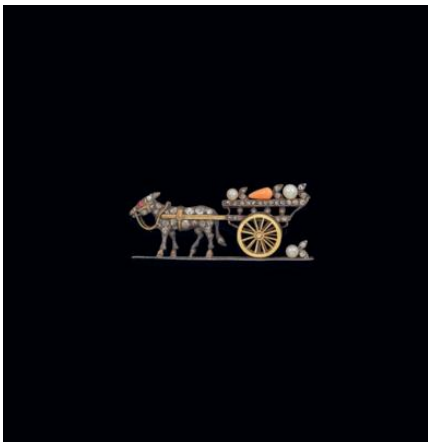
